Bishop Baker Issued a Letter 4/3 In Support of HB-314 & SB211

These would ban all abortions including those induced by medications, as soon as a woman is "known to be pregnant." There are exceptions for "lethal anomaly" & serious health risk to the mother. There are no exceptions for rape and incest. Violation of this law would be a felony.
