He was there when Christ was Baptized. It is said he was half of one of the 72 pairs of disciples sent out by Jesus and was there at the Ascension. He was chosen over Barsabas by lots between the Ascension and Pentecost. There are some interesting historical traditions about him including that they tried stoning him but it did not work. He is therefore often pictured with an axe because that is how he was said to be ultimately martyred.

#### Wed. 5/8 Saints of this day: Dionysia, Andrew and Peter

In the 1st Century Andrew & Paul were tried and martyred on the rack for their belief in Christ. Dionysia was tortured in the same time period and although protected from assault by an angel, she demanded martyrdom with Andrew & Paul. She was executed by the sword at another site shortly thereafter.
