Copies of sections 15, 16, & 17 are available in the back of the church for those who wish to join in. There are volunteer leaders for each of the sections.

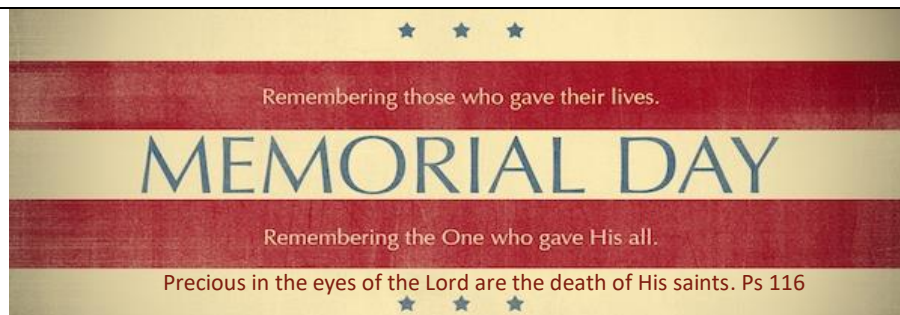
6/9 Celebration of Msgr. O'Connor's 65th Anniversary of Ordination
