

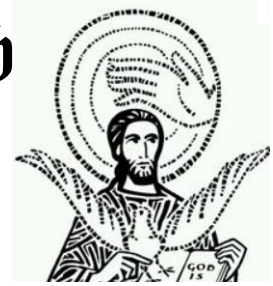

We will have a pot luck starting at 6:30 & the agenda will include:

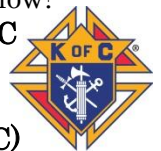
a donation to the Bishops' Scholarship Fund, plans for the Instillation of Officers
