He worked extremely hard for the poor and to reunite the Orthodox and Roman Church. He was eventually pulled from his residence savagely killed, dragged through the streets and thrown in the river. Some say his body “emerged, surrounded by rays of light.” He in buried in St Peter's Basilica.

Wed 11/13 Memorial of Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini

Founder of orphanages and hospitals and known by all Italian immigrants; she said. “I travel, work, suffer my weak health, meet with a thousand difficulties, but all these are nothing, for this world is so small. To me, space is an imperceptible object, as I am accustomed to dwell in eternity.”
